ORDER

THIS MOTION made by 1382769 Ontario Limited and 1622356 Ontario Limited (together, the “**Companies**”), for an order (i) extending the time for the Companies to make a proposal, (ii) approving the reports activities of Albert Gelman Inc. in its capacity as proposal trustee to the notice of intention proceedings of each of the Companies (in such capacity, the “**Proposal Trustee**”), (iii) approving the fees and disbursements of the Proposal Trustee as described in the third report of the Proposal Trustee dated August 20, 2026 and the appendices thereto (collectively, the “**Third Report**”) including the fee affidavit of Tom McElroy sworn August 17, 2026, and (iv) approving the fees and disbursements of the Proposal Trustee’s independent legal counsel, Miller Thomson LLP (“**MT**”), as described in the Third Report, including the fee affidavit of Shahed Khalid sworn August 18, 2026 (the fee affidavits are together referred to as the “**Fee Affidavits**”), was heard this day by videoconference in Ottawa, Ontario.

ON READING the first report of the Proposal Trustee dated May 18, 2026, the second report of the Proposal Trustee dated July 8, 2026, and the Third Report (collectively, the “**Reports**”);

ON HEARING the submissions of counsel for the Companies, counsel for the Proposal Trustee, and such other counsel that were present, no one else appearing for any other person although duly served.

SERVICE

1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the time for service of the notice of motion and all materials filed in respect of this motion is abridged and validated so that this motion is properly returnable today, and dispenses with further service thereof.

EXTENSION OF TIME

2. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the time for the Companies to make proposals to creditors, and the time for the Proposal Trustee to file such proposals with the official receiver, is extended to and including Monday, October 12, 2026 in accordance with section 50.4(9) of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act* (Canada).

APPROVAL OF PROPOSAL TRUSTEE’S REPORTS, FEES AND ACTIVITIES

3. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Reports and the activities, conduct and decisions of the Proposal Trustee described therein are hereby approved, provided, however, that only the Proposal Trustee in its personal capacity and only with respect to its own personal liability, shall be entitled to rely upon or utilize in any way such approval.

4. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the professional fees and disbursements of the Proposal Trustee and MT, as set out in the Third Report and the Fee Affidavits, be and are hereby approved.

5. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that this Order is effective from the date it is made and is enforceable without any need for entry and filing.

6. **THIS COURT FURTHER ORDERS** that for greater certainty, this order is effective in Estate no. 33-3368241, 33-3368242 and Civil Court file CV-26-104097 (which was assigned to the consolidated intention to make a proposal as a matter of administrative convenience).
