## **DEFINITIONS**

1. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that all capitalized terms not expressly defined herein shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Seventh Report.

## **DISSOLUTION OF 1827403 ONTARIO INC. AND 1950979 ONTARIO INC.**

2. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the Liquidator is authorized to dissolve each of 1827403 and 1950979 upon the Liquidator filing a certificate substantially in the form attached as **Schedule “A”** hereto (the “**Dissolution Certificate**”) with the Court, certifying that it has completed the Remaining Activities described in paragraph 33 of the Seventh Report, at which time the dissolution of both 1827403 and 1950979 will become effective.

## **DISCHARGE OF THE LIQUIDATOR**

3. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that upon the Liquidator filing a certificate substantially in the form attached as **Schedule “B”** hereto (the “**Discharge Certificate**”) certifying that all matters to be attended to in connection with these liquidation proceedings of the Companies have been completed to the satisfaction of the Liquidator, the Liquidator shall be discharged as liquidator of the Companies, provided however that notwithstanding its discharge herein (a) the Liquidator shall remain Liquidator for the performance of such incidental duties as may be required to complete the administration of the liquidation herein, and (b) the Liquidator shall continue to have the benefit of the provisions of all Orders made in this proceeding, including, without limitation, all approvals, protections and stay of proceedings in favour of Albert Gelman in its capacity as


Liquidator.

4. **THIS COURT ORDERS AND DECLARES** that, upon the filing of the Discharge Certificate, Albert Gelman is hereby released and discharged from any and all liability that Albert Gelman now has or may hereafter have by reason of, or in any way arising out of, the acts or omissions of Albert Gelman while acting in its capacity as Liquidator herein, save and except for any gross negligence or wilful misconduct on the Liquidator's part. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing, upon the filing of the Discharge Certificate, Albert Gelman is hereby forever released and discharged from any and all liability relating to matters that were raised, or which could have been raised, in the within liquidation proceedings, save and except for any gross negligence or wilful misconduct on the Liquidator's part.

#### **GENERAL**

5. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that the aid and recognition of any court, tribunal, regulatory or administrative body having jurisdiction in Canada or outside of Canada to give effect to this Order and to assist the Liquidator and its agents in carrying out the terms of this Order. All courts, tribunals, regulatory and administrative bodies are hereby respectfully requested to make such orders and to provide such assistance to the Liquidator, as an officer of this Court, as may be necessary or desirable to give effect to this Order or to assist the Liquidator and its agents in carrying out the terms of this Order.

6. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that this Order and all of its provisions are effective as of 12:01 a.m. Eastern Time on the date of this Order.
