**ENDORSEMENT**

- [1] Receiver moving for orders approving sale process, reports and fees.
- [2] Counsel Mr. Bialkowski attending for affected interests with concerns re potential imminent unilateral removal by receiver of vehicles on property. Receiver confirming that NEC deadline for removal is end of this month.
- [3] Receiver counsel confirming on record that receiver will move no vehicles off the property before March 20, 2026, and that it remains open to hearing from those affected as to arrangements they may wish to make themselves to move the vehicles off the property before end of this month.
- [4] Further, and for clarity in view of the interest of attending self-rep parties in virtual motion court today, including two gentlemen attending from “Amer’s iphone”: Receiver counsel Mr. Corney confirmed that he has heard from a lawyer called “Steve” who is currently on a cruise boat and unavailable, and from another

lawyer (who zoomed in briefly, ungowned, from Europe) called Mr. Fleisias. Mr. Corney confirmed he will respond to both those counsel.

- [5] Materials supporting relief sought in form of two draft orders, first Receiver order SALE APPROVAL PROCESS, second Receiver order labelled ANCILLARY. Both orders were reviewed, change made only to delete paragraph regarding effective without issue/enter.
- [6] Draft orders signed this day and to issue. **Issue/enter requested to be expedited by Court admin office.**
