ENDORSEMENT OF JUSTICE STEELE:

- [1] Case conference held on March 11, 2026, via Zoom.
- [2] The Receiver has a motion scheduled for March 17, 2026. Miller Thomson will also be bringing a motion that day to be removed from the record.
- [3] The Respondents request an adjournment of the Receiver’s motion until sometime after May 1, 2026, given that Miller Thomson is seeking to be removed as counsel of record.
- [4] In the circumstances the Receiver agreed to a short adjournment of its motion for 2 weeks to allow for Miller Thomson’s motion to proceed on March 17th and not to derail the Receiver’s sale approval motion.
- [5] Accordingly, Miller Thomson’s motion shall proceed at the time previously scheduled on March 17, 2026 (but for 30 minutes instead of 45 minutes).
- [6] The Receiver’s motion shall proceed on **April 1, 2026, at 10 am (90 minutes), via Zoom.** Because this case conference was held today changing the date from March 17 to April 1, 2026, the Respondent has approximately three weeks’ time to retain new commercial counsel and have new counsel prepare for the hearing, among other things.
- [7] The Receiver asked the court to make the return on April 1, 2026 peremptory on the respondents, which I declined to do today, given that I don’t have any details on the reasons that Miller Thomson seeks to be removed. I indicated that the Receiver may renew this request at the March 17, 2026 attendance, if appropriate to do so.
